THE CAUSE

LIA RELIEF TRUST

Revive are the charity arm of Dar Ul Arqam, which have, from Day One, been the spiritual home of Riders of Shaam. Therefore, it seemed natural to help support their causes this year. We will be fundraising for the Syrian Refugees and also the Orphans of Yemen. The projects you will be raising funds for are all eligible for Zakat, Sadaqah and Lillah, and Revive work towards a **100% donation policy**.

RAINBOWS CHILDREN'S HOSPICE

As the East Midlands' only hospice for children and young people, Rainbows is a place where life-limited children and their families can find care and support. Rainbows' incredible team of people help relieve symptoms, improve quality of life, support parents and siblings through their bereavements and care for children until the end. The project you will be fundraising for is to support Play Therapy for Terminally ill children. The Rainbows Project is Sadaqa and Lillah only (does not qualify for Zakat). Again, we are working towards a **100% donation policy** with Rainbows.

WHAT IS ZAKAT?

Zakat is a pillar of Islam and is a compulsory charitable payment that goes on to benefit the poor and those eligible. Your Zakat payment can care for orphans and the elderly, provide food and water, deliver healthcare and education, and even provide emergency aid.

Play Therapy – Target £10k **RAINBOWS HOSPICE** **LEICESTERSHIRE**

Emergency Aid in Syria

REVIVE SYRIA

Type: Zakat, Sadaqah, Lillah

Riders of Shaam have chosen to provide emergency relief for Syria. With the help of Revive, we have set ourselves a £25,000 target where these funds will provide food parcels, hot food, hygiene kits, support towards a bread factory providing bread and household rehabilitation. It goes without saying that Syria is the worst humanitarian crisis of our time.

- **£360 Supports an Orphan Child** in Syria for a **full year** (£30 Supports an Orphan for a Month)
- **£1,200 Provides Food Parcels for 40 Families** for a Month (£30 Per Family)
- **£1,200 Provides Hot Food for 30 Families** for a Month (£40 Per Family)
- **£100 Provides a Hygiene Kit for 5 Families** (£20 Per Family)
- **£100 Provides Bread for 5 Families** for a Month (£20 Per Family)
- **£130 Provides Household Rehabilitation** (Repairs to a family home or relocation if not repairable)

Syria: The children of Syria are growing up surrounded by destruction, disease and death. More than 80 percent of Syria's children have been injured, and around 3.7 million children have been born in the past five years amidst the ongoing conflict, meaning they have never known peace. Over 500,000 people have been killed in the conflict. As of March 2019, over 5.7 Million have fled the country according to the UN High Commissioner for refugees and a staggering 6.1 Million displaced internally



Emergency Aid for the Rohingya Refugees

ROHINGYAN REFUGEES IN BANGLADESH

Type: Zakat, Sadaqah, Lillah

Riders of Shaam have chosen to provide emergency relief for the Rohingya refugees that have fled persecution in Burma and are now living in refugee camps in Bangladesh. With the help of LIA Relief Trust, we have set ourselves a £25,000 target where these funds will provide water, shelter, Hifz orphan sponsorships, cataract surgery and educational books for children

- **£1,500 Provides a Deep Well providing 12 Taps** (£125 Per Tap)
- **£300 Provides Cataract Surgery for 10 People** (£30 Per Treatment)
- **£250 Provides a Shelter for a family of Six** (Contains a Kitchen Area, Sleeping Area and Living Area)
- **£250 Sponsors an Orphan Child to do Hifz for a year**
- **£100 Provides Study Books for 5 Students for a Whole Year** (£20 Per Student)

Rohingya: Since August 2017, more than 730,000 Rohingya Refugees, including 400,000 children, have fled violence in Myanmar and settled in Cox's Bazar in Bangladesh. These people faced discrimination, violence and extreme poverty for so long.

Many of these people walked for prolonged periods, to flee from the violence. They bring with them nothing but their disturbing stories of violence. Many have lost their family members through the violence. Children have become orphans, women have become widowed, raped and the end result is we have one of the largest refugee camps in modern times. These people are desperate, and many have suffered unimaginable levels of trauma.

With your help, we can provide much needed Emergency Aid to these desperate people, in the hope that they can rebuild their lives
